

PRELIMINARY STATEMENT

A. TERRITORY SERVED:

Electric energy is supplied by the District in the following areas:

1. Imperial Area:

This includes all of Imperial County lying west of the Algodones Sand Hills, including the incorporated towns of Calexico, Holtville, El Centro, Imperial, Brawley, Westmorland and Calipatria.

2. Coachella Area:

This consists of a portion of central Riverside County generally covering the Coachella Valley, and including the incorporated towns of Indio, Coachella, La Quinta and the communities of Thermal, Mecca, Thousand Palms and Bermuda Dunes.

3. Colorado River Area:

This includes the portion of Imperial County lying, in general, east of the Algodones Sand Hills and including the Bard District, the townsites of Winterhaven and Gordon's Well, which is west.

B. DESCRIPTION OF SERVICE:

1. Lighting and Miscellaneous Service:

For domestic and general lighting and small power installations, 60-cycle alternating current of 120 volts, 2-wire or 120/208 volts, 3 or 4-wire or 120/240 volts, 3 or 4-wire is furnished.

2. Power Service:

Three-phase, 60-cycle alternating current for power installations of 7½ horsepower or over at voltages of 120/208, three-phase, 4-wire, 120/240, three-phase, 4-wire, 277/480, three-phase, 4-wire or higher is available over portions of the areas served as provided in Regulation No. 1A, "Character of Service."

3. Available Service:

In districts where a certain standard voltage is now being served to one or more customers, a new customer applying for power in this district will be furnished the same voltage served to the other customers, provided it is feasible.

C. PROCEDURE TO OBTAIN SERVICE:

Other than for residential service, electric service from Imperial Irrigation District may be

obtained by making written application to the District upon standard forms supplied by the District for that purpose, setting forth the amount and type of service required, purposes for which the service is to be used and other detailed information as may be required, and by the satisfactory establishment of credit as provided in these regulations. For applications for service requiring material extensions of lines or investment of money by the District, a contract may be requested by the District as a requirement for such service.

D. ESTABLISHMENT OF CREDIT AND DEPOSITS:

After making proper application for electric service, it will be necessary, before this service can be rendered, for the applicant desiring service to establish his credit with the District, said credit being deemed as established if the applicant makes the required cash deposit or otherwise establishes his credit to the satisfaction of the District as set forth in Regulation No. 6A, "Establishment of Credit."

E. BASIS OF CHARGES FOR ENERGY:

In general, all energy furnished to a customer will be measured by means of a standard watt-hour meter furnished by the District. The exception will be in the case of service for street lighting and outdoor lighting.

Maximum demand for certain power and lighting purposes is measured by means of approved maximum demand meters. The maximum demand as referred to in the schedule of rates or in these regulations in the highest average demand measured in kilowatts as determined over a period of 15 minutes unless otherwise stated.

Minimum charge shall be determined by connected horsepower or kva.

F. RATE SCHEDULES:

All charges for electric energy furnished to a customer will be made on the basis of actual measured consumption, except in the case of irregular kilowatt-hour consumption, maximum demand, minimum charge, fixed charge or any combination thereof as set forth in the rate schedules as established from time to time by the Board of Directors of Imperial Irrigation District. Copies of rate schedules are available at any of the District offices.

G. COMPENSATION TO DISTRICT EMPLOYEES:

All inspectors, agents and employees of the District, while acting as such, are strictly forbidden to demand or accept any personal compensation for services rendered to a customer of the District.
